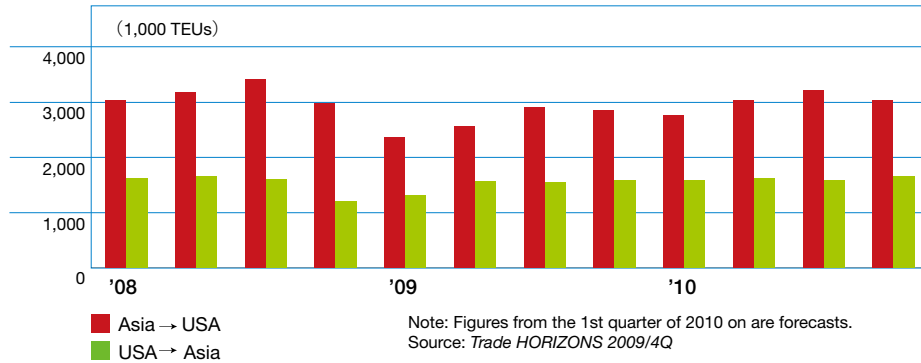

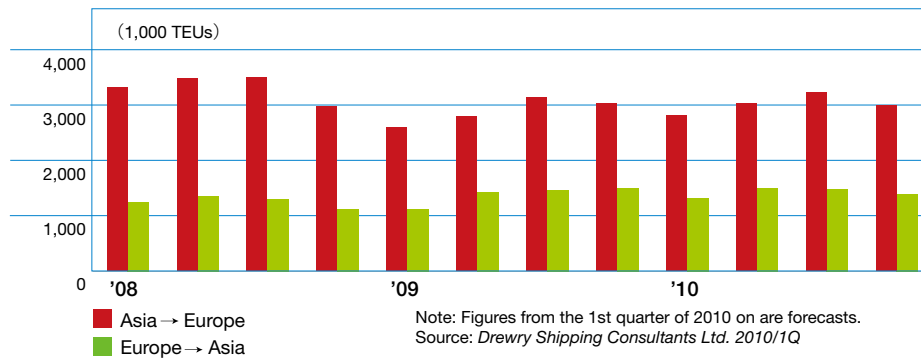

● Container Transport Volumes

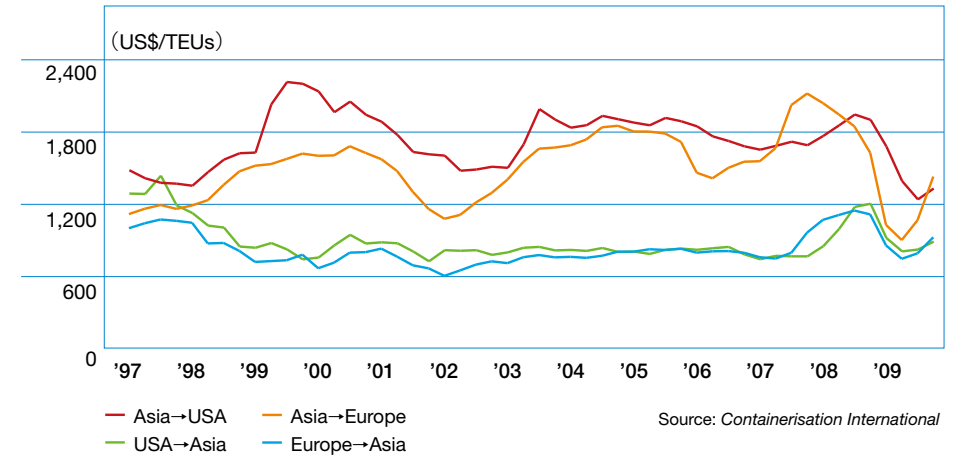
Asia ↔ USA (Quarterly)



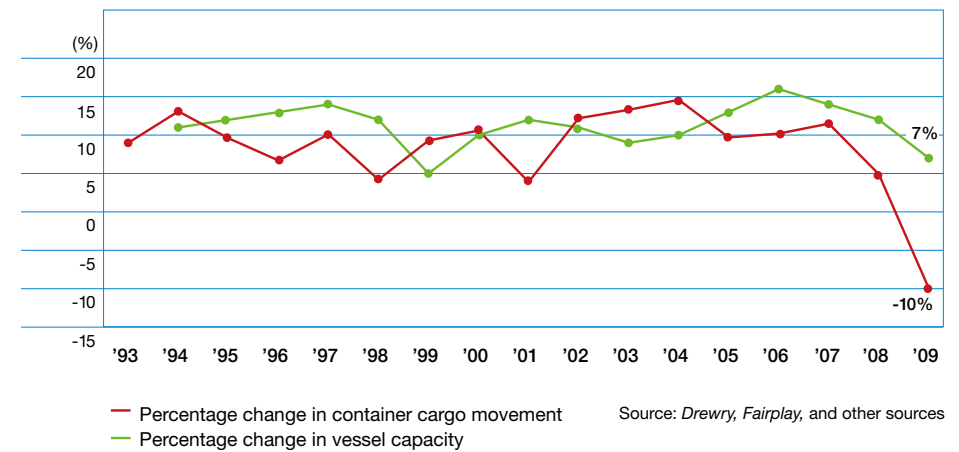
Asia ↔ Europe (Quarterly)
