### Liner Trade Business

Consists of the container shipping business that mainly transports general consumer goods, and the terminal business that offers terminal and stevedoring services around the world.



### Air Cargo Transportation Business

In the air cargo transportation business, Nippon Cargo Airlines Co. Ltd. (NCA), a consolidated subsidiary of NYK, provides international air cargo services linking Japan to North America, Europe, and Asia.

### Automotive Business

In addition to exporting finished automobiles from Japan to overseas destinations, we endeavor to develop infrastructure ahead of our competitors. Our efforts include trilateral transport and the construction of coastal transportation networks, as well as the construction and operation of dedicated terminals for finished automobile in various parts of the world.



### Dry Bulk Business

We safely transport bulk cargo—iron ore, coal, wood chips, and other goods indispensable for global economic activities—for many years, and we pursue transportation technologies and fleet development according to the characteristics of the cargo we handle.



### Energy Business

We're dedicated to conventional energy transportation of crude oil, petroleum products, chemicals, LPG, LNG and coal, as well as offshore business which is mainly upstream and midstream oil and gas related business. In recent years, we also focus on next-generation/zero emission fuels and renewable energy-related business development.
